We did not do a collection of items here because the needs have changed so quickly. I know the needs will be shifting from rescue to recovery now. We will be having a 2nd Collection next weekend that will help raise money to assist efforts to rebuild. I am also gathering information of what parishes need help both in terms of manpower and supplies. I will try to distribute these out as soon as I get them.
