We have close to 70 people who have already registered. I look forward to making this journey with you during Lent.

Finally, with the start of Lent there is also a change for the location of our Saturday 4:00pm Mass. It has been a custom that on the 1st Sunday of Lent, the location changes to the other Church in the cluster. So beginning on March 4th, the Saturday Mass will be at St. Elizabeth.
