A Message about a former parishioner/organist at St. Jules:

Last Sunday Dorothy Cancienne Joffrion retired as a Catholic Church organist. She has been playing the organ in various Catholic churches for the past 72 years. Her career began in St. Jules Church, Valenzuela, LA.

My mother, Dorothy Cancienne Joffrion, was born in Belle Rose, LA, and baptized at St. Jules, Valenzuela. She began volunteering to play the organ at St. Jules, Valenzuela shortly before her marriage in 1945 (she was married in the church at Valenzuela). She said that the organ she played in Valenzuela was a pump organ. Later, she volunteered as an intermittent organist at St. Jules in Belle Rose. She, on occasion also played at St. Elizabeth's in Paincourtville, LA, and in Donaldsonville. In Paincourtville, she had the privilege of playing the old Cavaille-Coll organ before its tragic and mysterious disappearance.

While her playing for the last 52 years has been at her parish church, St. William's, in Carthage, Texas (she and her husband, Olin Joffrion, moved to Texas in 1965) she played for her first 20 years as an organist primarily at St. Jules. There were paid organists, but her work was strictly voluntary and she was not usually the primary organist, but rather an intermittent or substitute organist.

Her mother, Sartola Cancienne, was a long time member of St. Jules Parish and her brother, Pat Cancienne and her sister-in-law Rosa Mae continue as members of St. Jules. Many of her other relatives are members of St. Elizabeth's and St. Jules'.

She said that, for the most part, her playing has been a joyful experience.
