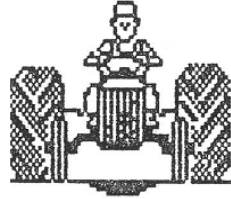

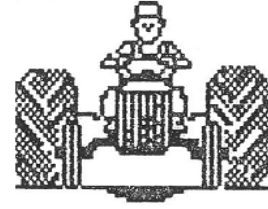
**Homebound Ministry**
